

## Statutory Declaration

I, [REDACTED] do hereby solemnly declare and affirm that:

In around 1980 I had a conversation with the second owner of 14 Reserve Street, Mr John Henwood for whom I had a lot of respect, and who owned said property from about 1959 to 1973-74, coincidentally he owned the dredging operation that helped to build up Koala Park. The conversation was had while I was helping his eldest son, who was a friend from childhood, on a property they owned out at Talle Valley. In that conversation we were talking about the difference in starting up a business when he started to starting a business then in the 1980's, amongst many other things. In the course of that conversation he told me that he got the section of Tabilban Street that ran along the side of his house not to be finished off and sealed with asphalt, telling me he did not want cars running through on both sides of the house.
